3. Personal data may be transferred to third countries (outside the European Economic Area), in particular in connection with the Controller's use of global IT solutions. Data may be transferred to third countries for which the European Commission has issued an adequacy decision. In the case of third countries for which such a decision has not been issued, data transfers may in each case be carried out using one of the safeguards aimed at ensuring an adequate level of data protection referred to in Chapter V of the GDPR. Information on the safeguards referred to in the preceding sentence can be obtained by contacting the Data Protection Officer using the contact details provided in point I section 4.

III. Rights of the data subject

1. Each data subject may exercise the following rights provided for in the GDPR:
 - **a) right of access** – to obtain confirmation from the controller as to whether or not personal data concerning them are being processed. Where personal data concerning a person is being processed, they are entitled to gain access to it and obtain the following information: the purposes of the processing, the categories of personal data concerned, information about the recipients or categories of recipient to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed, the envisaged period for which the personal data will be stored, or the criteria used to determine that period, the existence of the right to request from the controller rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing of personal data concerning the data subject or to object to such processing (Art. 15 GDPR);
 - **b) right to obtain a copy of the data** – to obtain a copy of the personal data undergoing processing, where the first copy is provided free of charge, and for any further copies requested, the controller may charge a reasonable fee based on administrative costs (Art. 15 sec. 3 GDPR);
 - **c) right to rectification** – to request the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning them, or to have incomplete personal data completed (Art. 16 GDPR);
 - **d) right to erasure** – to request the erasure of personal data concerning them, if the controller no longer has a legal basis for processing it or the data is no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which it was processed (Art. 17 GDPR);
 - **e) right to restriction of processing** – to request the restriction of personal data processing (Art. 18 GDPR) when:
 - the accuracy of the personal data is contested by the data subject - for a period enabling the controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data;
 - the processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the personal data and requests the restriction of their use instead;
 - the controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but they are required by the data subject for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims;
 - the data subject has objected to processing pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the controller override those of the data subject;
 - **f) right to data portability** – to receive the personal data concerning them, which they have provided to a controller, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to request transmission of those data to another controller, where the processing is based on the data subject's consent or on a contract and the processing is carried out by automated means (Art. 20 GDPR);
 - **g) right to object** – to object to the processing of personal data concerning them based on the legitimate interests of the controller, on grounds relating to their particular situation, including profiling.
